Directions:

From Chewelah Peak Learning Center to Usk (20 miles):

- Go to the end of the CPLC driveway and turn left (east)
- Follow this road until you get to a T-intersection (road to the left is paved, to the right is dirt) turn left (north)
- Follow this road until you get to another T-intersection (Hwy 20) go straight across the road to Usk
- Go past the mill and over the bridge
- Immediately after the bridge turn left (north) Note: “Kalispel Indian Reservation” sign
- Go approximately 1 ½ miles, you will see the 27,000 square foot building on the left, turn left before the building

From Spokane to Usk:

- Travel Interstate 90 or Highway 2 to Spokane.
- Take Highway 395 to the north, through Spokane. The signs will direct you to Hwy 395 and Colville; Hwy 395 follows Division and Ruby Streets through the city of Spokane
- Take a right at the Y on the north end of Spokane to Hwy 2 (also known as the Wandermere area)
- Travel Highway 2 north east out of Spokane all the way to Usk (through Newport) or take the Hwy 211 cut off, before Newport, until you get back to Hwy 2 just below Usk (around mile post 421.) Watch for a brown sign that reads “49 Degrees North Recreational Area” just before milepost 421.
- Go past the mill and over the bridge
- Immediately after the bridge turn left (north) Note: “Kalispel Indian Reservation” sign
- Go approximately 1 ½ miles, you will see the 27,000 square foot building on the left, turn left before the building

From Usk to Chewelah Peak Learning Center (20 miles):

- Go back to Hwy 2 from Usk.
- Go straight across Hwy 2 on McKenzie Road and follow a sharp 90-degree turn to the left and then the right. McKenzie Road becomes W. Calispell-McKenzie Road two miles from Hwy 20 and then at four miles it becomes the Flowery Trail Rd.
- Follow the Flowery Trail Road until you see the exit for Chewelah Peak Learning Center (1 mile beyond the exit to the ski hill.)
