Added to the wealth of knowledge they have acquired as ASB and leadership class advisers, both Leanne and Sue are directors of a summer leadership camp.

What Will Participants Learn?

The goal of the retreat is for you to walk away with many of your questions answered regarding working with student leaders. Strengthen the curriculum in your leadership class or advisory through exploring different student leadership models. Improve your skills as an adviser and team facilitator by experiencing a variety of group process techniques. Gain new ideas for homecoming, assemblies, socials, fundraisers, student and staff recognition programs and school spirit. Clock Hours: 10 clock hours available for an additional fee of \$20

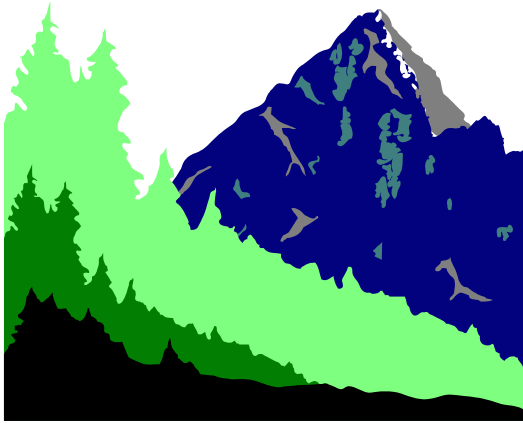
