Who Should Apply?

Elected or appointed student leaders who would serve as outstanding representatives from their school are encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to students who are:

- Recommended by their school as outstanding leaders.
- Members of the graduating class of 2011 and 2012.
- Current members of the WASC Board.
- Members of the 2010 WASC Conference planning committee.
- Selected at the state and national level to be Small Group Workshop presenters at the NASC Conference.

The Trip Is More Than a Student Tour!

As a member of our state delegation there are high expectations for behavior. Students unable to accept this responsibility should not apply to be a member of our delegation.

35 Spaces Available

The National Association of Student Councils provides each state with a delegate allotment for the annual NASC Student Leadership Conference. **Our goal is to fill the Washington state delegation with 35 top student leaders from 35 different high schools in our state!** Our 2010 allotment of 35 spaces must be filled by February 19, 2010. Two delegate spaces **may** be allotted per school on a space available basis.

Cost

- \$1600 per delegate includes conference registration, round-trip airfare, lodging, ground transportation, admission fees, most meals, and t-shirts. Some additional money is needed for breakfasts and souvenirs. The trip will begin at both the SeaTac International Airport and the Spokane International Airport. Participants will be responsible for their own transportation to their preferred point of origin.
- Schools which are not members of the National Association of Student Councils are encouraged to join or will need to pay an additional \$100 for non-member conference registration.
- Non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due on February 19. Final payment is due on June 1, 2010.
Cancellation policy: After March 19 all expenses incurred by Washington Student Leadership will be non-refundable.

Important Deadlines

Our deadlines are based on the deadlines we must meet with the National Association of Secondary School Principals' office. Thanks in advance for observing these timelines.

- January 29, 2010:** (Optional) Small Group Workshop applications due to Washington Student Leadership.
- February 19, 2010:** NASC Conference School Reservation Form due with a deposit of \$500 per delegate.
- April 12, 2010:** Official NASC Registration and Medical Permission Forms due for each delegate. This deadline cannot be extended!!
- May 1, 2010:** Changes after this date may require additional fees due to airline requirements and NASSP procedures.
- June 1, 2010:** Final payment due.
- June 23-29, 2010:** An amazing experience! The 74th NASC Conference and pre-conference trip.
