- ❑ **RSVP** is a student engagement program sponsored by the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP) and the National Association of Student Councils (NASC). The **Washington Association of Student Councils and the Association of Washington School Principals** enthusiastically endorse the **RSVP** model for student engagement and school improvement.
- ❑ **RSVP** is easily integrated into existing student council programs. Student leaders plan and facilitate a series of summits that engage the entire student body in dialogues about school improvement. Student action teams to carry out plans for resolving concerns identified in the summits.
- ❑ **RSVP** asks students what they care about, what proposals they have for community and school improvement, and what actions can be taken, in cooperation with adults, to implement their ideas for positive change.

- ❑ School teams will become the RSVP coordinators in their schools. Bring seniors only if you plan to implement this year. Your team should include at least one junior or sophomore.
- ❑ Training fee of \$150 (\$175 non-members) includes four RSVP implementation guides, materials and a mid-morning snack.
- ❑ Plan to arrive by 8:45 a.m. for check-in.
- ❑ This focused training will be held from 9:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. with only short breaks. Be prepared for intense, active learning.
