



## Phone Calls

*Cingular cell phone service works well from Chewelah Peak while Verizon cell coverage is sporadic at best. Students can use a prepaid phone card for calls home from the public phone in the dining hall. Camps keep to a busy schedule and there is little time to call home.*

The mission of the Chewelah Peak Learning Center is to furnish functional, aesthetically sound facilities, and curricular resources for supporting outdoor education and leadership training to young people. The beautiful 30-acre campus is located one-hour north of Spokane, 11 miles from the town of Chewelah and across from the 49° North ski resort.
