YOUR GOAL

To attend the statewide leadership camp in Washington for middle level student leaders and advisers.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

You were selected to represent your school at this leadership conference. You will be one of over 200 delegates at camp. As a representative of your school, you will be expected to be a positive participant in all activities. In general, camp rules shadow basic school rules; wear appropriate clothing, respect yourself and others, be on time, etc. Those students who do not follow the camp behavior expectations will be sent home.

YOUR CAMP EXPERIENCE

By participating in this experience you will develop your leadership potential, meet new friends, and discover how you can serve your school. You will gain new skills in the areas of group process, communication, and project organization. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to work with over 200 positive leaders from schools around the state.

CAMP SHIRTS

Camp t-shirts and sweatshirts will be on sale throughout camp week. Bring cash or checks made out to AWSP Leadership. Prices range \$10 - \$30.

PAY PHONE/EMERGENCY PHONE

In the case of an emergency while you are at camp, your family can reach a camp director by calling 360-497.5323 (Leadership Office). After hours you can call 360-497-7131 (Cispus Office). **There is no cell phone service at Cispus.** Parents: Your son or daughter will be actively involved at camp. There is a pay phone available to call home. Please keep in mind, however, that all delegates share this phone, and lines may be long. Therefore, your child may not be able to check in with you each day. Pay phones do not accept cash, so please plan to bring a calling card if you intend to use the pay phones.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Reminder: Please register students who can commit to attending camp from start to finish.

The opening session will begin on Thursday, August 13, 2009, at 1:00 p.m. Plan to arrive at Cispus between 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. This will give you time to move into the dorms and to have lunch in the dining hall before we begin. Camp will conclude at 12:30 PM on Sunday, August 16, 2009. You will receive a sack lunch for the road as you depart.

ADVISER SESSIONS

If you are attending as an adviser, be prepared for an active, information-filled seminar. On occasion, you will be with the student delegates, however, the bulk of your program will be with other advisers as you gain new skills to enhance the student activities at your school. Plan to arrive and depart at the same time as the student delegates. Advisers will be housed in an adult dorm. Twenty clock hours (\$40) are available.

MEDICAL CARE

A nurse is on duty to handle routine and emergency medical situations. Every camper must have a completed medical form on file with the camp nurse. If your son or daughter becomes so ill that he/she needs a doctor's attention, you will be contacted and billed for the visit.

*All medications **MUST** be turned in at the nurses table during the registration process at camp.*

The accident insurance of Association of Washington School Principal's Student Leadership Program is secondary to your coverage.

CANCELLATIONS

If something happens and you will not be able to attend camp, it is important that you do the following:

- Students: Contact your adviser or principal **immediately!** Your school is counting on you. With advance notice, your adviser/principal will probably be able to find a student to attend in your place. Otherwise, your ASB will forfeit your space AND the money they paid so you could attend.
