



# La Cima Bilingual Leadership

June 25-29, 2012 ~ Chewelah Peak Learning Center

*We impart leadership and life skills to Latino youth in Washington State*

## **What is La Cima Leadership Camp?**

Washington Student Leadership is committed to Latino students in Washington. At La Cima, students participate in a leadership curriculum that is recognized nationally as a model of excellence. Through an interactive, weeklong camp experience, students learn and practice essential skills such as teambuilding, communication, creative thinking and public speaking. La Cima staff is composed of teachers, counselors, administrators, professionals and college-age role models dedicated to serving Latino youth.

## **Who should attend?**

La Cima is designed for Latino high school students entering grades 9-12, who wish to make a positive difference in their schools and communities. **La Cima is not a language camp.** We seek students with a broad range of leadership experience and skills from high performing to those with untapped potential. These student leaders can be elected, appointed or recruited. La Cima also encourages ASB officers from schools with a large Latino population to attend. Camp is open to 125 delegates. There is a limit of 8 students per school, and no more than 2 of these may be previous La Cima participants.

## **What language is spoken at camp?**

Leadership lessons are held in both English and Spanish. The camp atmosphere is open and welcoming to students who are fluent in both languages as well as students who only speak English or Spanish. The camp is staffed with adult leaders from both ends of the linguistic spectrum.

## **What is the cost?**

The cost for students coming from schools that are members of the Washington Association of Student Councils is \$160 (non-member schools, \$170).

## **What about transportation?**

Charter bus service to and from Chewelah Peak Learning Center (located one hour north of Spokane) is available for an additional fee. Students can also be transported to camp by their school, sponsor or parent. **Student drivers are NOT allowed.**

## **How do I register students?**

Both schools and sponsoring agencies can register students for La Cima Leadership Camp. The registration process consists of five steps:

1. Complete the School or Sponsoring Agency Form to secure a spot at camp for your students.
2. Decide on a method of payment (check, credit card or purchase order).
3. Provide the student leaders with the Delegate Registration/Medical Form to complete. It must be completed, signed and mailed to Washington Student Leadership.
4. Contact the student leaders to verify they have received a registration confirmation. We send a confirmation to the students upon receiving a Delegate Registration/Medical Form; we send a confirmation to you upon receiving the School or Sponsoring Agency Form.
5. As the date of camp nears, continue to connect with the student leaders to reassure them of their choice to attend the life-changing experience of La Cima and help them finalize their transportation arrangements. Students either sign up for our charter bus service or they are transported to camp with an adult driver.

**Cancellation Policy:** Schools or sponsoring agencies may cancel delegate spaces up to May 31 with a full refund. All cancellations received after May 31 will result in a non-refundable processing fee of \$50 plus transportation fees. If cancellation is made less than five working days prior to camp (June 18, 2012), the full charge of camp plus transportation will apply. Full charges will apply for delegates who leave early or do not show up for camp. All cancellations must be received in writing from a school official by the specified date.
