United States Senate Youth Program Scholarships

Annually, each state selects two student leaders to participate in the United States Youth Senate program sponsored by the William Randolph Hearst Foundation. State winners participate in a week-long program in Washington, DC and receive a \$5,000 scholarship. In Washington State, taking part in an AWSP sponsored Summer Leadership Camp is the only way to become eligible for the scholarship. A selection process is held during each session of camp, with finalists competing at the state level for the honor of representing Washington in this prestigious program.

Who should attend Leadership Camp?

Camp is designed for high school students entering grades 9-12 who want to make a positive difference at their school.

Students may or may not hold an elected office. We require that they are recommended and registered as part of an official school delegation. Washington State Leadership Camps provide outstanding opportunities for all students. Consider sending officers from ASB, Class, NHS, Career & Technical Club, Cheerleaders, Student Council Reps, Team Captains and other emerging leaders.

What curriculum is covered?

Leadership Camp is an intensive week of leadership training with delegates from all areas of Washington State.

Group Process
Problem Solving
Human Relations

Where is Leadership Camp?

Six sessions are held at the Cispus Learning Center, 12 miles southeast of Randle, Washington in the Gifford Pinchot National Forest. Two of the sessions are held at the Chewelah Peak Learning Center, approximately one hour north of Spokane near the 49 Degrees North ski resort. The Association of Washington School Principals operates both facilities. Family-style meals are served in a dining hall, and delegates are housed in dorms.

Why should I attend?

Positive, trained student leaders make a difference. School principals believe this...that is why they sponsor the Washington Student Leadership programs. Since 1956, Washington's student leaders have been attending "Leadership Camp."

You'll find past delegates still leading in business, education, government and communities. Make a difference for yourself and others...register for Leadership Camp now!

- Please register students who can commit to their camp session from start to finish! All camps start at noon on day one and conclude in the afternoon on the final day.
- Delegates must be entering grades 9-12, be enrolled in high school, and be registered as a part of a school delegation.

RESERVE YOUR SPACE

You may reserve your space at the camp session of your choice by completing the School Reservation/Registration Form and returning it with an official school purchase order or check, made payable to AWSP. Schools may reserve delegate spaces up to May 31st. If delegate forms are not postmarked by May 31st, reserved spaces will be relinquished.

Cispus- 16 delegates per school, per session / 6 days - 5 nights - \$265/\$275 (WASC Member/Non-WASC Member)
Chewelah- 8 delegates per school, per session / 5 days-4 nights - \$255/\$265 (WASC Member/Non-WASC Member)

DELEGATE FORMS

Please register students who can commit to their camp session from start to finish! Mail a complete, legible and signed Delegate Registration/Medical Form for each delegate. We need the original signatures, please do not FAX.

TRANSPORTATION

1. Students may use the charter bus service arranged by the Association of Washington School Principals. Buses are scheduled based on the registration requests. Delegates riding the bus should plan to ride round trip. Students using our bus service will be notified of their pickup location and departure time approximately one week prior to their camp session.
2. Delegates may be transported to Leadership Camp by a school official, a parent, or an adult authorized by the school. **STUDENT DRIVERS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellations received after May 31st will result in a non-refundable processing fee of \$50. If cancellation is made less than five working days prior to camp, the full charge of camp plus transportation will apply.
