### Who should attend Leadership Camp?

Middle Level Leadership Camp is open to...

- students enrolled in middle schools or junior highs entering grades 7, 8, or 9; *and...*
- students holding elected offices or students with an interest in developing leadership skills; *and...*
- students who are part of the official school delegation.

### What curriculum is covered?

Middle Level Camp is a unique leadership experience designed specifically for middle level students. The staff is composed of enthusiastic, highly trained, and dedicated teachers, counselors, administrators, and college students. The curriculum is based on the goals and objectives of **Washington Student Leadership**. Through large group and small group activities, students learn a variety of useful skills that will help them in their development as positive school leaders. Some of the topics include:

### Where is Leadership Camp?

Three sessions are held at the Cispus Learning Center, 12 miles southeast of Randle, Washington, in the Gifford Pinchot National Forest and one session is held at the Chewelah Peak Learning Center, approximately one hour north of Spokane near the 49 Degrees North ski resort. Both facilities are operated by the Association of Washington School Principals. Family-style meals are served in the dining hall, and delegates are housed in dorms.

### SAVE YOUR SPACE

Complete and return the School Registration Form with an official school purchase order or check, made payable to AWSP. Process your school registration early to secure your spaces. There's no need to wait until elections are over to reserve your space.

### REGISTRATION FEES (Delegation Size and Fees)

Cispus- maximum 14 delegates per school, per session / 4 days-3 nights - \$195/\$205 (WASC Member/Non-Member)  
Chewelah- maximum 8 delegates per school, per session / 4 days-3 nights - \$195/\$205 (WASC Member/Non-Member)

### DELEGATE FORMS

Please register students who can commit to their camp session from start to finish! Delegates must be entering grades 7, 8, or 9, and be registered as a part of the official school delegation. Mail a complete, legible and signed Delegate Registration/Medical Form for each delegate. We need the original signatures, please do not FAX.

### ADVISER WORKSHOP

An optional adviser workshop runs concurrently with each session of camp. Participants attend their own seminar, designed specifically for middle level advisers. Mail a complete, legible and signed Adviser Registration/Medical Form for each adviser attending. Twenty clock hours, or two university credits are available for an additional charge. Fees, registration and cancellation policy are the same as for student delegates.

### CANCELLATION POLICY

Schools may cancel reserved delegate spaces up to May 31<sup>st</sup> with a full refund. All cancellations received after May 31<sup>st</sup> will result in a non-refundable processing fee of \$50. If cancellation is made less than five working days prior to camp, the full charge of camp will apply. Schools are charged the full amount for delegates who leave early or do not show up for camp.
