ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE TIMES

MEDICAL CARE – A paramedic is on duty to handle routine and emergency medical situations. If your son or daughter becomes so ill that he/she needs a doctor's medical attention, you will be contacted. All medications **MUST** be turned in at the registration table during the registration process. Every camper must have a completed medical form on file. The Accident Insurance of the Association of Washington School Principal's Student Leadership is secondary to your coverage.

CANCELLATIONS – If something happens and you will not be able to attend camp, it is **IMPORTANT** that you contact your adviser or principal immediately! Your school is counting on you. With advance notice, your adviser/principal will probably be able to find a student to attend in your place.
